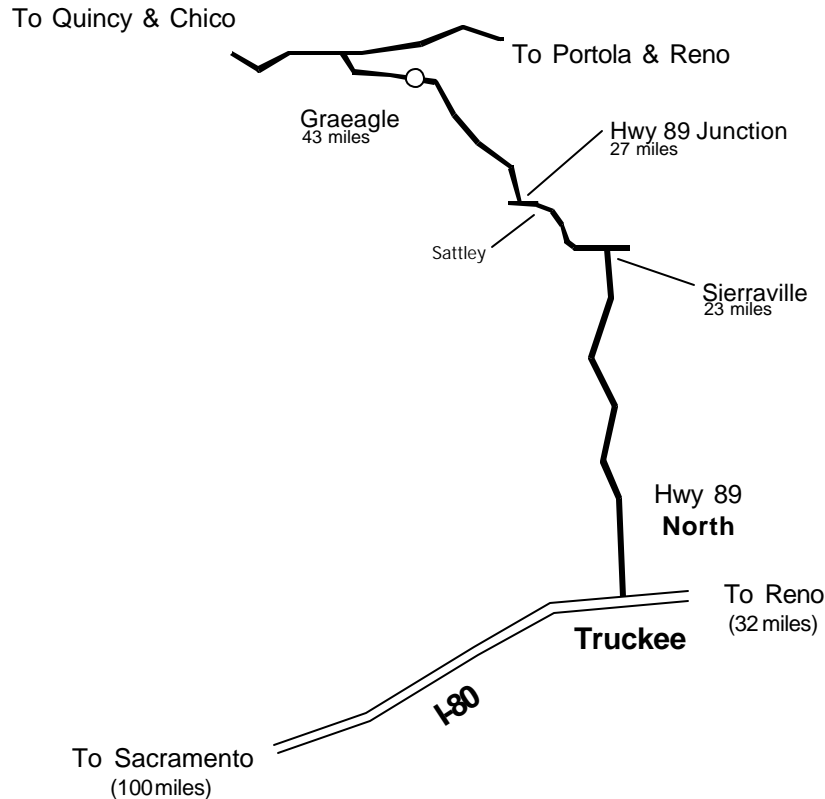


Directions to John and Janet's Graeagle Home



Graeagle is 250 miles from Santa Rosa. Expect about a 4-1/2-hour drive in good traffic. Add for commute times, holiday getaways, and weather delays. We usually stop at the Marie Callender's in Auburn for a mid-trip break and stretch (Grass Valley exit). The Wild Cherries Coffee house in Truckee also serves up very nice caffeinated treats for the road-weary traveller (Take the first Truckee exit eastbound; left at the stop; about 1/2 mile on the right, next to the fire station).

Directions from Truckee:

- From I-80, take Highway 89 **North** (not South!) towards Sierraville. Set your trip odometer to zero at this point.
- Follow Highway 89 for 23 miles to Sierraville. Watch out for deer, especially at night, and road ice in winter. Obey the posted speed limit in Sierraville, and **turn left at the stop sign**.
- After passing through Sattley, be sure to **take the Hwy 89 right turn towards Graeagle**.
- Continue following Hwy. 89, following all signs towards Graeagle and Blairsden.
- Shortly after passing the Gold Lake turnoff at 43 miles, you will enter the town of Graeagle
